-What people do you have difficulty reaching out to, caring for, or doing things for? ...be honest!
3. We've learned over the past few weeks about the perception and difficulties that the Jews had with the Samaritans, and how Jesus dealt with that social perception and barrier...
...READ Matthew 28:19-20 and Acts 1:8 together, and describe how the Lord's command directly relates to our lives today, and what our responsibilities are in the lives of others... (READ Matthew 5:13-16 for even greater detail) -What is the significance of Jesus including "Samaria" in His instructions? (Acts 1:8)
4. What did you hear or learn from tonight's episode and/or discussion that helps you to see people the way the Lord Jesus sees people? What effect does that have on your life today?

Take a few moments to share any Prayer Requests with the men in your Group. Write down any requests and commit to pray for one another throughout the week.
(It's great to know that other guys are praying for the important things in your life...and it's great to be praying for the important things in their lives!)
